This memo provides information to help school districts understand allocations for those currently funded to receive state-administered funds to operate af **State**d Universal Prekindergarten Program (UPK) and/or for those districts eligible to receive funds for the 2021-2022 program year and subsequent years through the UPK FelgeFalnded Allocations

There are two parts to this memo. The first part applies to those districts who **Statefended** UPK funds and the second part to districts who will receive funds through the UPK Fyederal Funded Allocations.

Memo Part I: For districts with 2023-2024 State-FundedUPK Funds

Universal Prekindergarten (UPK) grant funds are allocated to school districts in accordance with a formula set forth in Section 3602-e (10) of Education Law. The 2023-209244StateFunded Allocations List can be accessed on the NYSED Office of Early Learning website.

The chart on the following page defines the contents of each column of the UPK Allocations List.

Half-Day Conversion Overage

In New York State, prekindergarten funding is meant to be used for the provision datyfull programming for three and/or foyear old students. To discourage districts from converting/fayll slots to halfday slots for either thregear old or fouryear old students, NYSED institutes a half y conversion overage penalty. This penalty is only applicable to districts who receive UPK allocations designated specifically for the provision of full

Memo Part II: For Districts with UPK Federally-Funded Allocations
