To determine if the student is ready for online coursework check the following statements that apply to the student you are considering for a virtual course.

The student is self-motivated and self-disciplined.
The student is a good "time-manager."
The student is comfortable with e-mail and word processing.
The student can read analytically and critically.
If the student set their sights on an end result, they usually achieve it.
The student is confident in their academic abilities.
The student does not give up easily, even when confronted with obstacles.
The student believes they are responsible for their own education.
The student has conflicts with work, athletics or child care and school activities.
The student has convenient and frequent access to a computer with an internet connection.
The student is willing to try something new.
The student is willing to express their thoughts and opinions in writing.
The student is willing to work in a loosely structured environment.
If you have checked at least 10 statements, online learning may be right for your student.

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
